2. COUNTY: Suffolk TOWN/CITY: Islip VILLAGE: Bayport


3. DESCRIPTION: The flagpole in the Bayport Park was originally the mast of Sir Thomas Lipton's racing sloop, Shamrock II, built c.

> It was the gift to the village of the Todd family who owned a summer residence on Middle Rd. (see BA 20). William Todd, a Brooklyn shipyard industrialist, and owner of Todd's Basin in Brooklyn, bought the old Brown Farm in 1905. The mast of the Shamrock II was used as a flagpole there until it was donated to the village park.

4. SIGNIFICANCE:

The flagpole is a relic of the days when the first ocean racing sloops competed for the America's Cup. Sir Thomas Lipton was a wealthy tea manufacturer.
