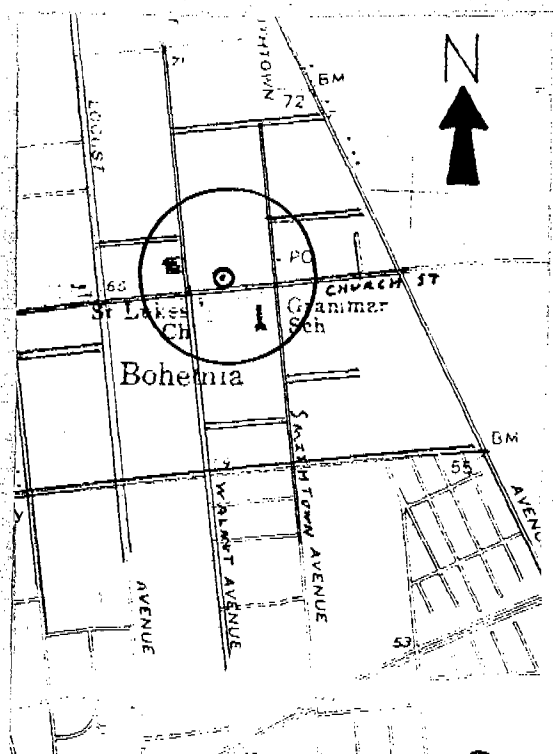

The Stockel House is located on the north side of the street opposite the Union Cemetery (BO 9) among residences of similiar age and scale.

18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):

The Stockel House is a 2½ story, gable roof house with a semi-hexagonal two story bay window with gabled pediment on the west part of the main facade. The house contains a porch across the principle (south) facade with a projecting gable and squared posts on a knee-wall.
