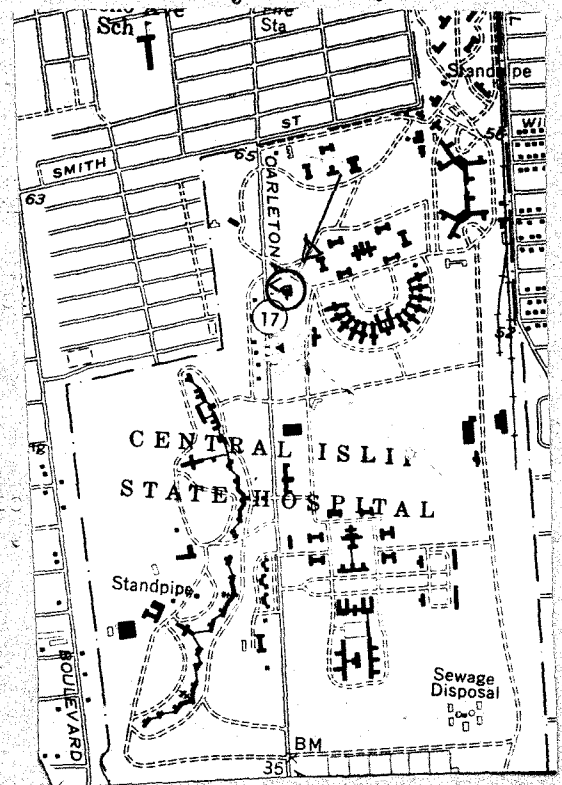

## 20. HISTORICAL AND ARCHITECTURAL IMPORTANCE:

The building is a 2-story brick Colonial-Revival building with entrance on all four elevations, 3 bays on the west facade and 9 bays on the north & south facades. Truncated hip roof, flaring out at eaves over exposed rafter ends with dutch parapet facade gables on north and west facades. Hip roof dormers also with exposed rafter ends. Double deck porch on west facade with paired tuscan columns. Brick arched window heads with granite keystones and sills. Granite water table. A 2-story bay window on south facade.
