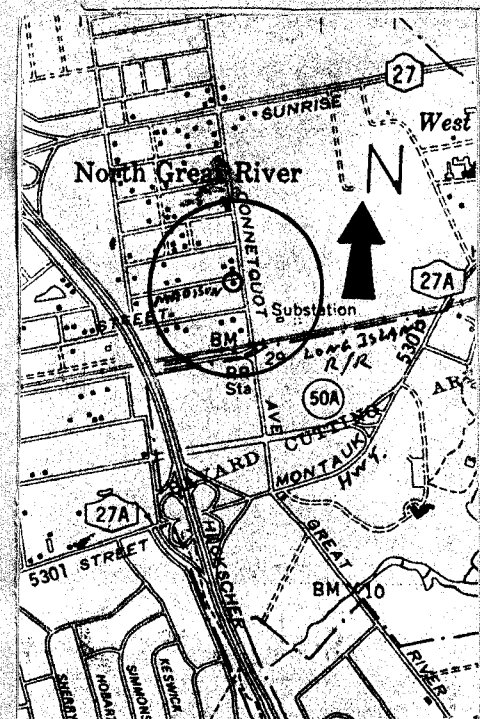

18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE:

148 Connetquot Avenue is a 2 1/2 story, three bay, side entrance plan, hip roof house with a single bay south wing that contains a two story, semi-hexagonal bay window with an overhanging gable roof. The house features a semi-wrap around porch with tuscan columns. The principle (east) roof slope contains a pedimented dormer with a paired window.
