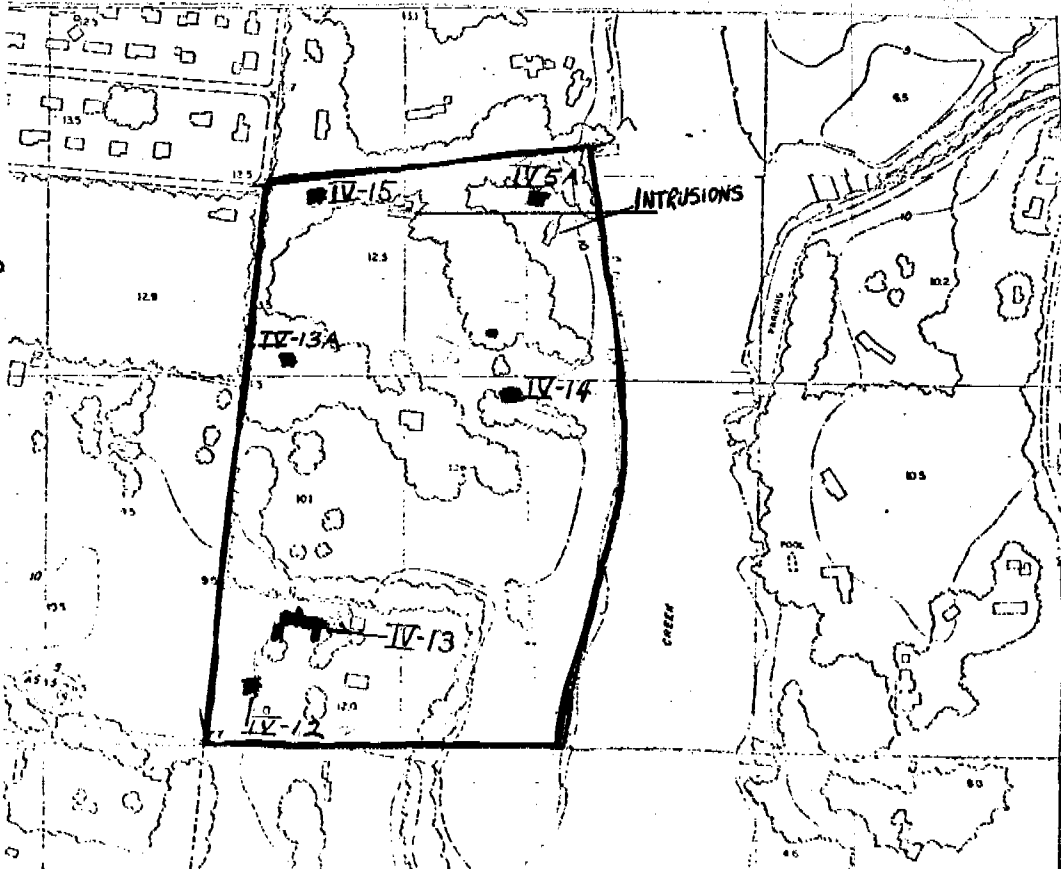

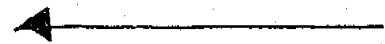

Mrs. J.S. Lovering residence - St. Mark's Lane (IV-12)

Stick Style cottage,
jog in roofline.
sawn decoration on rafter ends under eaves, (see IV-2,
clipped gables. Willow St, district
original windows with diamond window panes
in upper sash.
original corbelled angled brick chimney.

Mrs. Harry T. Peters residence - St. Mark's Lane (IV-13)

"Windholme kennel."
former Peters cowbarn (main Peters house was torn down).
brick towers.
cupola with ventilator.
shingles above,
brick below.
outbuilding with eyebrow window dormer.

Martin residence - St. Mark's Lane (IV-14)

originally Peters garage.
6 acres
dairy and icehouse.
garage designed by Stanford White.
ca. 1903-1905.
original windows.
interior improvements.
belvedere on 2nd floor.
original cast iron gate with stone pineapples on
stone posts.
19th century wooden fence painted green with
turned posts and knobs.

Peters Estate cottage - St. Mark's Lane (IV-15)

hip roof with wide flaring overhang,
curving brackets.
original brick chimney with corbelled brick top
at an angle to front facade.
eyebrow window in roof.
same 19th century fence as Peters garage.

Farm building from Peters Estate -300 Maple Street (IV-15A)

- brick foundation
- garage-coach house
- house nearby is modern
- diamond shaped windowpanes

- probably moved

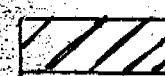
