

This year's Christmas Card features Steve Moore's drawing of the original Vanderbuilt Conservatory, which is located in the midst of what is now known as Dowling College. The Conservatory housed Consuelo Vanderbuilt's suitors whenever the 110 room mansion did not provide enough space.


Then in 1903, a second Conservatory was built to store and grow Mr. Vanderbuilt's prize winning plants and orchids. The original conservatory has not yet been restored. It connects two sections of Dowling College and is used for storage.
