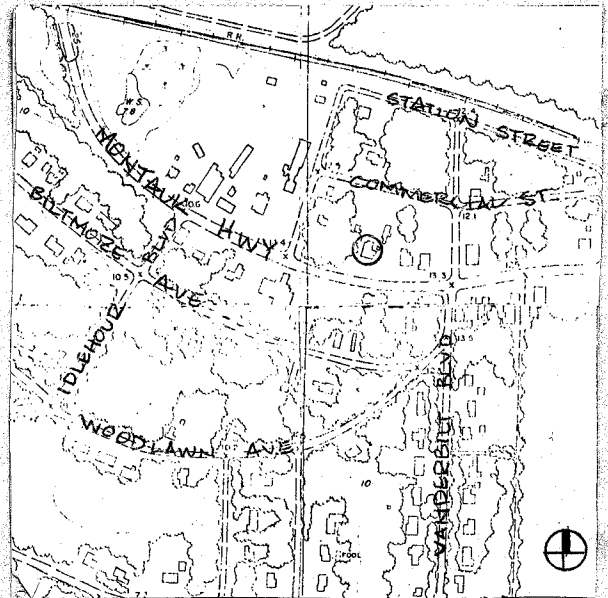
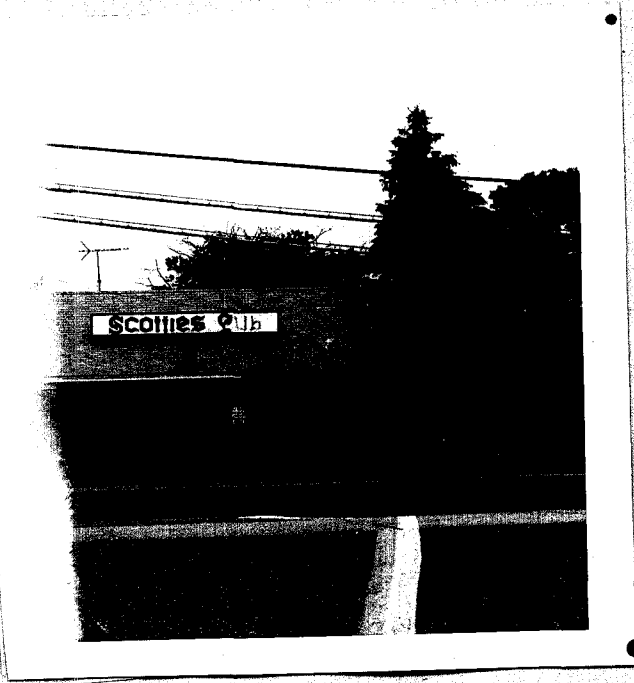

1½ story, 5 bay clapboard structure, with a gable roof that has a sweeping overhang which forms an open porch at the front. This flaring overhang is supported on 6 slender wooden Tuscan columns.

Scottie's Pub was originally the Clubhouse of the Westbrook Club, which was located west of the Connetquot River.

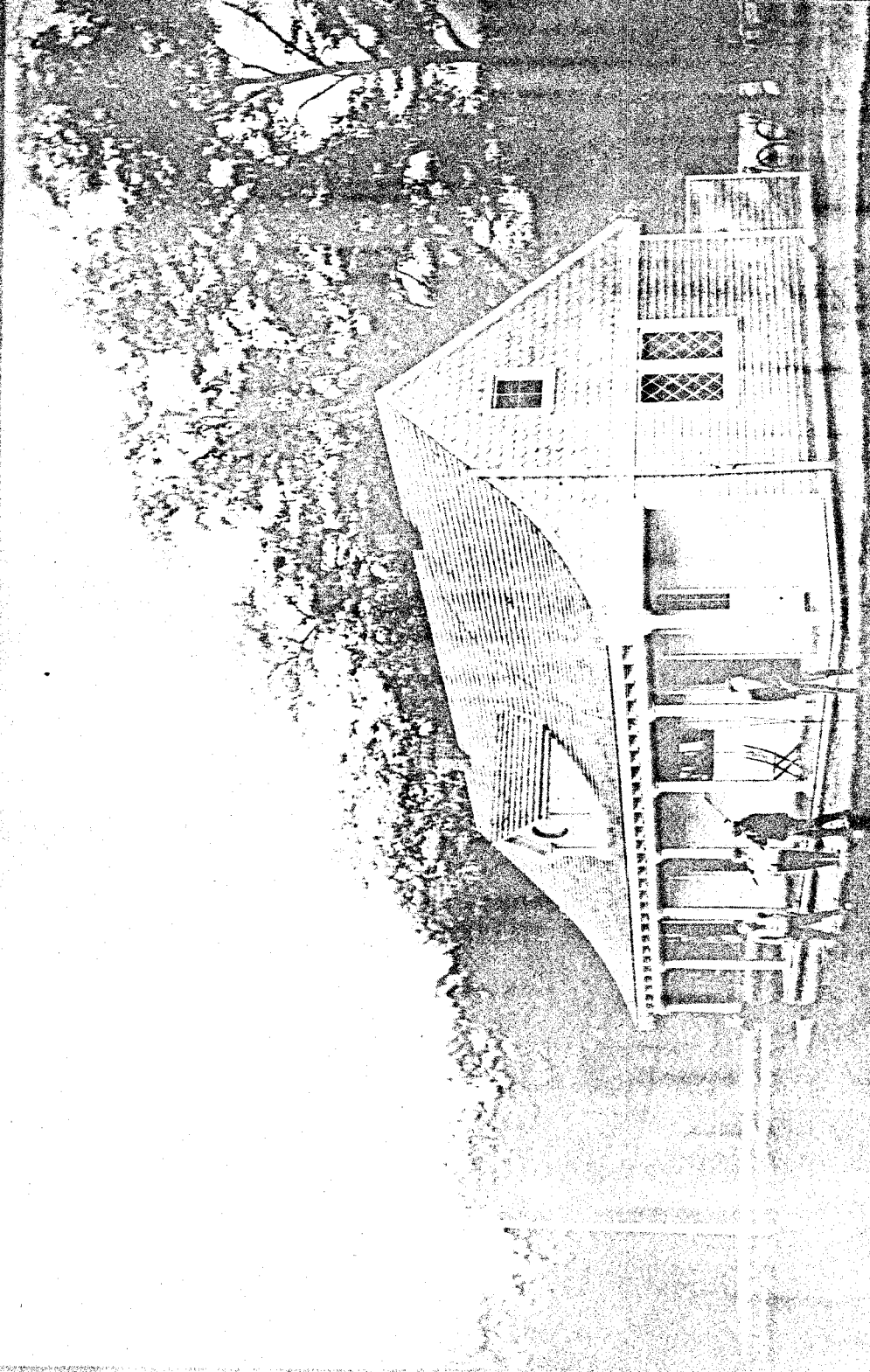
