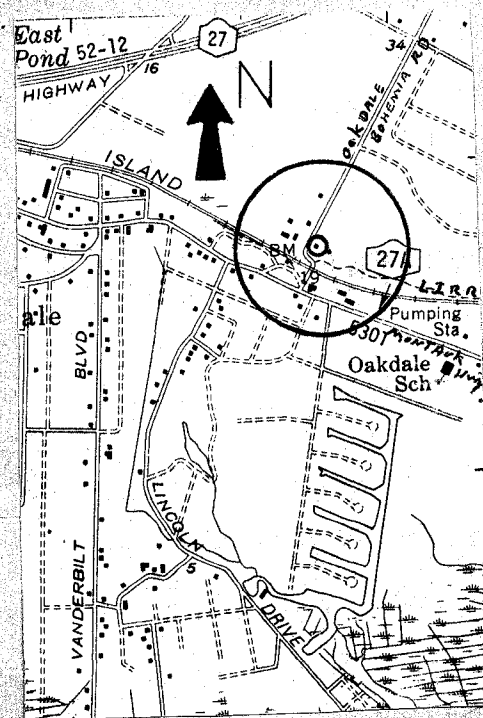

5 Oakdale - Bohemia Road is located on the east side of the street opposite the Long Island Rail Road tracks. The house faces south. Oakdale - Bohemia Road is a residential street that links the commercial routes of the Sunrise Highway and Montauk Highway.

18. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known):
 5 Oakdale - Bohemia Road is a 1½ story, three bay, center entrance plan, gable roof house with a projecting gable roof entrance wing on the south flanked by tall 6/6 windows. A pedimented wall face dormer is centered on the south roof slope.
