

Set back from the road, the building is fronted by a large paved parking field and is one of the largest and most architecturally prominent buildings on the street. OTHER NOTABLE FEATURES OF BUILDING AND SITE (including interior features if known): 90 Higbie Ln. is a large, two story, parapet roof, T-shaped brick building Projecting entrance wing has six giant columns in antis. The tripartied recessed entrance has a round arch door with scrolled pediment flanked by additional round arch doors with oculus above. Original 8/8 windows with voussoirs remain.
